

OK-LSAMP Annual Research Symposium Directions and Parking

The Annual Symposium is held in the Noble Research Center on the Oklahoma State University, Stillwater Campus.

If coming from I35:

Take Highway 51 east to Stillwater (about 16 miles). Take a left on Western Avenue.

The road will curve to the right and become Hall of Fame. Then, you may

- Continue on Hall of Fame until you get to Monroe Avenue. Take a right. Then, take a left into parking lot 31. (Part of this lot is closed due to construction.)
- **OR** continue on Hall of Fame until you get to Washington Street. Take a right into Parking Lot 29.

If coming south on Highway 177:

Do not turn when Highway 177 turns west. The road will become N. Washington Street. When the main road angles left, veer right in order to stay on Washington Street. Continue on Washington Street until you enter Parking Lot 29 OR go right on Hall of Fame and left on Monroe. Take a left into Parking Lot 31.

If coming north on Highway 177:

Highway 177 will become Perkins Road and then veer left to S. Main Street. Take Perkins Road OR S. Main Street to Hall of Fame. Take a left on Hall of Fame and continue passed the stadium. At Washington Street, turn left into Parking Lot 29 OR continue on Hall of Fame and take a left on Monroe Street. Take a left into Parking Lot 31.

If coming west on Highway 51:

Continue on Highway 51 / 6th Street. Take a right on Main Street. Take a left on Hall of Fame.

Continue on Hall of Fame passed the stadium. At Washington Street, turn left into Parking Lot 29 OR continue on Hall of Fame, take a left on Monroe Street, then a left into Parking Lot 31.

The Symposium is held on Saturday. Therefore, parking in staff parking lots is permitted. However, **special reserved spaces such as Handicapped and Physical Plant Parking are enforced 24 hours a day / 7 days a week.** Be sure to have the proper permits if parking in one of these spaces. Below are the parking regulations for Special Events as taken from the Department of Parking and Transit Services website.

Special Events

Athletic and Fine Arts Performances attract large numbers of visitors to the Oklahoma State University campus. Typically, athletic event parking is assigned through the Posse Office within the Athletic Department. **Fine Arts and conference activities** at such locations as the SERETEAN Center for the Performing Arts, the Wes Watkins Center for International Trade Development, Student Union, or the ConocoPhillips Alumni Center **are typically held after enforcement hours.** Please contact your conference planner or sponsor for information regarding parking availability or call the Department of Parking and Transit Services at 744-6525 for parking information.

Should a visitor receive a parking citation, please contact the Department of Parking and Transit Services at 744-6525 for proper disposition of the ticket. Visitors that receive a parking citation for the first time may get that ticket waived. However, excessive violations or violations for parking in reserved or restricted parking areas, such as disability or spaces signed for specific vehicles will be enforced. It is our wish to provide adequate parking for visitors to Oklahoma State University.
